Jacopo Zambello was born in Rovigo in 1999. He studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Venice. In 2022, he won the Painting section of the 14th edition of the Nocivelli Prize. In 2023, he received the Martini International Award at the San Fedele Visual Arts Prize and was included in the book *222 Artists to Invest In*, published by Exhibart. He was an atelier resident at the Bevilacqua La Masa Foundation in Venice for the 2023–24 term. In 2025, he was among the winners of the eighth edition of We Art Open.
