

AGNIESZKA BRZEŻAŃSKA

Born in 1972, currently lives in Warsaw. She studied at the Academy of Fine Arts in Gdańsk, in Warsaw, and at the Tokyo University of Fine Arts and Music. Her work explores elusive links between various natural forces and life forms on Earth, which she perceives as Gaia, a living organism. In this, she uses various registers of knowledge, from physics and philosophy to systems of cognition marginalized by modern science, such as alchemy, parapsychology, esotericism, native knowledge or matriarchal traditions. She is also interested in contemporary ecological practices. She is an author of paintings, drawings, films, photographs and ceramics.

MARTYNA CZECH

Born in 1990. Received the main prize at the 42nd Bielska Jesień Painting Biennial while still a student at the Katowice Academy of Fine Arts. Drawing on the heritage of New Expressionism, harmonizing with the themes raised by the artist on canvas, she has developed a characteristic painting technique. Czech's paintings become a space for working through the relationships between the artist and others. She is interested in intense feelings: love, hatred, revenge, humiliation, submission, resistance, and pain, as well as death. The characters she presents not take on ambiguous moral roles and attitudes, obfuscating the interpretation of the above categories and making ethical judgments. Although her paintings are dominated by the analysis of toxic interpersonal relationships, animals are also significant — as the companions of misery, witnesses of massacres, and harbingers of the apocalypse.
