ADAM PARKER SMITH

b. 1978, California, USA Lives and works in Brooklyn, New York

Adam Parker Smith's practice is primarily sculptural, relating to painting, wall relief and appropriation. Following an extended conceptual project that consisted of Smith stealing his colleagues' work, the artist turned toward a more traditional – perhaps earnest – approach to art-making. Working largely with 'faux' materials of all sorts, he creates highly composed, brightly colored sculptures and wall pieces that flirt with the surreal. Smith is known for bright and often humorous works that contemporize classical sculptural forms through an existential lens. He has an MFA in painting and attended the Skowhegan School of Painting and Sculpture and received the New York Foundation for the Arts Fellowship in Painting.

Working in solid resin, urethane, steel and marble, Smith fashions familiar objects that are often made to appear inflated and dispensable. His sculptures, in the manner of readymades, are universally accessible and quietly satiric, capturing levity within the sublime subjects. Smith has exhibited work across the US and internationally, and has been written about in Art in America, Artforum, the New York Times, the New Yorker and many other publications. Adam's Sarcophagi series, featured in his recent solo exhibition at the Hole, was installed at the Watermill Center, NY in the summer of 2022 and is currently on view till March 2023.
