

Darby Milbrath is a self-taught painter whose practice is imbued by her past as a contemporary dancer and herbalist, lending to her figurative painting and its process a sense of movement, drama, and solemnity. Growing up in the West Coast Gulf Islands, this fertile and sublime landscape manifests in her art as recurring motifs. Thus, her expressionist paintings come from memory and imagination and are informed by nostalgia, visions, and mysticism. Through non-verbal approaches, both contemporary dance and painting demand the implication of the body, intensity in presence, and an authentic expression of the self to truly transcend the complexities of human life and emotions as experienced. The cyclical nature of ebb and flow, death and rebirth, are ongoing themes explored in Darby's paintings which express empathy, sensuality, sorcery, womanhood, and ceremony. Her paintings are intimate and confessional self-portraits of her life as a young woman.

She holds a Bachelors of Art with honours from the School of Contemporary Dancers in affiliation with the University of Winnipeg.
