Graduated in Fine Arts, Degree in Painting from the University of Chile and Master in Arts, mention in Visual Arts from the same institution. Lives and works between Santiago de Chile and Madrid, Spain. His work focuses on concepts related to the investigation and interpretation of personal and collective memory.

In 2016 he was awarded a grant by the AADK Network Spain platform to carry out a Project and Artistic Residency in the city of Murcia, Spain, obtaining funding from the same organisation to produce a Video-Documentary in different locations in Morocco. He has exhibited individually and collectively inside and outside Chile, exhibiting his work in various institutions, galleries, museums, fairs and artistic residencies, highlighting the Museum of Contemporary Art of Buenos Aires (MACBA), Argentina; Centro Párraga de Murcia, Spain; Museum of Contemporary Art of Santiago (MAC), Chile; El Apartamento Gallery, Madrid, Spain, Patricia Ready Gallery, Santiago de Chile; D21 Gallery, Santiago de Chile; Vigil Gonzáles Galería, Cusco, Perú; Feria ARCO Madrid, Spain; ZONA MACO, Mexico City, Mexico; Hangar Art Residency / Centro de Investigación y Creación Artística, Lisbon, Portugal; ZK-U, Berlin, Germany; Reset Proa 21, Buenos Aires, Argentina; as well as being selected in Contemporary Art Publications and Catalogues of specialised magazines and newspapers such as ART News; Artishock; Terremoto; El País; Babelia; Artes y Letras de El Mercurio; La Panera, among others. He has been awarded on two occasions the FONDART competition in the lines "Ventanilla Abierta: Circulación Internacional", as well as "Ventanilla Abierta: Residencias".
