She has been awarded residencies at MacDowell, Stoneleaf Retreat, Art Omi and Yaddo, which named her the recipient of the Milton and Sally Michel Avery Residency in 2018, the Philip Guston and Musa McKim Residency in 2023. Through 2020 to 2022, Fukuyama participated in the Ground Floor Program at International Studio & Curatorial Program (ISCP), where she was celebrated as their studio honoree. She is a recipient of the 2022 Guggenheim Fellowship. She is currently working on an upcoming commissioned work for The Aldrich Contemporary Art Museum and Lighthouse Works.
