Alexis Aurora is an interdisciplinary artist originally from southeastern Manitoba, Treaty 1 Territory, the traditional lands of the Anishinaabe, Cree, Oji-Cree, Dakota and Dene, and the homeland of the Red River Métis. In 2015, his solo exhibition was presented in two locations; Peeks of Present at AIR Antwerp and at Diesel Project space in Liège (Belgium). In 2017 Aurora presented Through The Looking Glass Darkly at Four Seasons NY, Brooklyn. Several times supported by the Manitoba Arts Council, the Canada Council for the Arts, and in 2018 he was awarded the Keith Evans Prize from the Banff Center for Arts and Creativity. Aurora holds a BFA from the University of Nova Scotia College of Art and Design (NSCAD) and attended the Cooper Union School of Art in New York.

Aurora will present their first solo with the gallery later on this year in October 2024.
