ANNEKE EUSSEN

Anneke Eussen is known for glass sculptures made from recycled glass from various sources, including buildings and cars. Usually, these materials are discarded when their original use has ended. In Eussen's hands, they form the starting point for her carefully composed wall sculptures. Eussen uses the recycled glass sheets in their original dimensions and conditions, choosing to preserve rust, dust and stains to create minimalist but painterly compositions reminiscent of colourless flags or fictional maps, as well as the borders and fenced environments they contain. Through a process of arranging and assembling found materials to create translucent sculptures, Eussen explores the sensory connection between past, present and future, and our relationship with built environments. Eussen's works have many art historical precedents, from the ready-made sculptures of Marcel Duchamp to the use of typical disposable materials by Arte Povera artists. Eussen adds a formalism to the work of these predecessors. The result is elegant sculptures that oscillate between a modernist aesthetic and an unconventional materiality.

Anneke Eussen (NL, 1978) lives and works in Vaals (NL). Recent solo exhibitions have taken place at Kunstverein Schwerin (DE), Tatjana Pieters, Ghent (BE) and DOCUMENT, Chicago (USA). In 2023 she was part of 'Gist,' an art triennial in Brussels (BE) and 'Space as a Duty of Care,' curated by Daniele Capra at Galleria Studio G7, Bologna (IT), amongst others. Eussen is represented by Tatjana Pieters, Ghent (BE), Marinaro, NY (USA) and DOCUMENT, Chicago (USA). She won the Legacy Purchase Program at Art Basel Miami 2023. Her work is now part of the public collection of the city of Miami next to private collections worldwide.

Letter : to Anneke Eussen

Near the end of August 2020, I absent-mindedly walked into the gallery of Tatjana Pieters. It must have been the first exhibition I visited in months. 'Absent-minded' in the sense that I was not aware which show was scheduled exactly at the gallery, the whole corona situation tends to distract one's thoughts. I was the only one present at the gallery and I did not know who was being shown at the time. In other words, it was one of those rare occasions in which you find yourself in front of works of art without knowing who made them, whether the artist is young or of age, male or female, without knowing the origin of their maker... The exceptional moment between work of art and beholder and what happens in the space between them when there is no distraction or contamination of information, biography or reputation. Unhindered perception, a skill we have sadly lost in recent times. The art of painting was my first thought while regarding the works. Not painting in the conventional meaning of the word, but in the sense that the exhibited works clearly connect to a painterly tradition. The glass panels evoked reminiscences of Marcel Duchamp and the tradition

of the ready-made, but also notions of layerdness, translucence and the idea of a gesture (or its absence). The marble plates carried me to the trompe-l'oeil tradition, but also to the marble of palaces and principalities, the stone tapestries of the cultural and political elites. But of course there was more to it. Any reference is but a temporarily meaningful display of knowledge. Thus I attempt to move beyond, to descend into my perception and experience : 'Adding the blank pages (02)' (2020) and 'Big Triumph (02)' (2020). The selection is random, not declaring any preference. It is made solely to get closer, as closely as possible, to the work. Both works are evidently part of a series, with distinct points of origin, but terminations unknown to us. It shows how much importance you, as an artist, attach to exploring variations of the same, like moves in the game of back gammon. 'Adding the blank pages (02)' is an almost square surface having sides 45 cm each, consisting of different glass panes mounted on wood within a Perspex frame. The glass panes show traces of use, are seemingly smoked, opaque, fuliginous. They had to leave behind whatever they may have been

before, a window or see through to something else. Indirectly, they have become samples of used time, filters of a past view. The glass panes are windshields of post-war automobiles and construction machines, archaeological remains of symbols of the modernist faith in progress. They have gathered dust through the times and elements of nature. Drawings and traces seem to have been made by an invisible hand. Your intervention is to withdraw the glass panes from oblivion, to organize them with aesthetic conviction into compositions, geometrically abstract appearances. The title 'Adding the blank pages (02)' contains two elements. The concept of addition -which is a sculptural act- and the myth of the blank slate, the utopia we long for but which is never desirable. None of our actions, thinking or doing ever have an unspoiled start. In this regard 'Adding the blank pages (02)' is an image of remembrance, a memento mori, a mirror of our transience. 'Big Triumph (02)' (2020) is related yet different. Here too, a material is recovered, that is marble pieces of the former 'Staatbibliothek' in Berlin. Black little wires, nailed to the wall, carefully relieve the marble pieces

from gravity. They are fragments of marble with a history. A geological time reaching back to the Pleistocene on the one hand, a political time on the other, taking us to Germany before 1989. The anecdote of the marble's origin is not of prime importance to me. What interests me, touches me even, is the precarious nature of this work. I would call it a kind of care almost or recovery, the way in which the small black wires keep those marble plates in place. The contours are read as words of a sentence, the surface as a body's veined skin, the downward spiralling motion as the melancholy of rain. While formally both series unfold from the beauty of the fragment, I experience a worldview in these works, a window that astutely embraces the precariousness of man and of our world. Presumably, all of these reflections were already conceived in my mind before I learned that you are the creator of this work : Anneke Eussen.

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Glass Works Series, 2018 - ongoing

Short Term Utopias on Anneke Eussen's Recent Works by Ory Dessau

Either mounted directly on the wall or placed inside a plexiglass case, Anneke Eussen's formally varying, provisional constructions of layered glass elements are a self-referential proposition highlighting the physical conditions in which they are made, displayed and perceived. Combining recycled dusty panes with untouched tailored ones, each glass construction is a double feature, an inexhaustible bidirectional movement, in the course of which the frame, the glass elements, and the wall merge into and separate from one another. The to and fro movement performed by Eussen's glass constructions provides them with temporality, turning their space into an event in time.

In the works, the means of display become the displayed objects, outside becomes inside, transparency becomes opacity. Eussen's glass constructions mark the shift from a transparent to an opaque field of vision, and as a

consequence, from a clear to an inaccessible view of the world. Most of the dusty glass panes were removed from windows of discarded cars, lending the strictly phenomenological character of the works a narrative quality that infuses the experience of 'here and now' with aspects of 'there and then.' Eussen's glass constructions not only deconstruct conventional modes of display, they also summon the imprints of the sights that were seen through the windowpanes they recycle and the lives of those who saw them. In this sense the recycled glass panes are like relics—traces of what has been long gone—or rather, flat crystal balls evoking past time chronologies.

Almost all the glass constructions are titled. The titles given by Eussen can serve as a key to the meaning of that which otherwise defies meaning. For a 2020 series of nine encased glass constructions made

of both dusty and transparent panes, Eussen chose the title Adding the Blank Pages. The title defines her layered arrangements as an act of adding, accumulating, piling. It also emphasizes the fundamental emptiness and lack which the glass constructions enact, describing them as blank. However, at the same time, the title signifies the panes as pages, i.e., as a potential medium of inscription. As layered pages, the series implies a unified ground to which it was once, and maybe will be again, bound. Nowadays, the term 'blank pages' is likewise associated with computer programs of textual outputs. As such it allows us to relate to Eussen's glass constructions as an effect of materialization of what was previously virtual; as a response to the digital communication systems to which we are subjected.

In a recent solo exhibition at Tatjana Pieters Gallery (Little

Triumph, July-September 2020) Eussen juxtaposed her glass constructions with a new group of wall mounted marble sculptures. In them, broken marble tiles from the ruins of Berlin's former city library are held together by black wires nailed to the wall. Each sculpture consists of broken marble tiles with only one or two straight edges. Eussen connected the broken tiles along their remaining straight edges to create a temporary illusion of a continuous surface whose cracks we observe upon approaching the wall. Expressing her effort to smoothen the cracks, as well as her understanding they cannot be eliminated, testifies to the essential ambiguity of Eussen's practice, where the motivation to restore and obtain unity is met with the impossibility to fully do so.

KEVIN MCNAMEE-TWEED

(ENG)

Kevin McNamee-Tweed's practice investigates the mechanics of meaning-making and storytelling. Embracing broad material exploration, McNamee-Tweed creates images and objects that narrate, measure, or express nuances of human experience and material reality. While much of his work may be naturally situated within the context of image-making, painting, and drawing, McNamee-Tweed works extensively with clay. Incorporating native clays and regional traditions from his home in North Carolina, the artist relies on time-honoured as well as idiosyncratic uses of clay and glaze materials. He makes intimate, utilitarian objects and many things which situate themselves between categories, such as function-resistant objects, ceramic books, and wall-hanging pictorial ceramics, which have become his primary focus in recent years.

McNamee-Tweed's pictorial ceramics or 'ceramic paintings,' employ meticulous techniques, controlled processes, and tempered experimentation to achieve image-based corporeality featuring exaggerated surfaces, textures and visual effects. Relating intimately to the hand and the eye, these book-sized objects carry a strong element of storytelling. Often with pathos and playfulness, his narratives include personal, mundane, or grandiose ruminations, while his stylistic tendencies and formal sensibilities span references from the art-historical to the commonplace. Frequently, his imagery reflects on traditions of image and object making, with particular emphasis on quotidian visual culture, the history of painting, and, the immense lineage of practical application and artistic expression with ceramics.

Kevin McNamee-Tweed (US, 1984) is based in Durham, North Carolina. Recent solo exhibitions include The Greenville County Museum of Art (Greenville, SC), Tatjana Pieters (Ghent, Belgium), The Institute of Contemporary Art in Chattanooga, Steve Turner (Los Angeles), Cob Gallery (London, UK), L21 Gallery (Mallorca, Spain), and Dutton (New York). He has participated in group shows in Germany, France, Italy, Spain, Iceland, Greece, the UK, and Australia. Reviews of his work have appeared in Artforum, Art in America, The New York Times, The Los Angeles Times, The Los Angeles Review of Books, Artnet, Glasstire, and Hyperallergic, among others. He is the recipient of numerous awards and residencies including the Ella Fountain Pratt Award, the Mildred Pelzer Grant, the Willhelm and Jane Bodine Fellowship, The Iowa Arts Fellowship, and the Montello Foundation Fellowship. A monograph on his ceramic work was published by Steve Turner (Los Angeles) in 2020. Upcoming projects include exhibitions at Museum Lucien De Gheus in Poperinge, Belgium and JVDW Gallery in Dusseldorf, as well as new books, including a monograph surveying McNamee-Tweed's interdisciplinary practice. He is represented by Steve Turner Gallery (Los Angeles), Dutton Gallery (New York), and Tatjana Pieters (Ghent, Belgium).

KEVIN MCNAMEE-TWEED

Kevin McNamee-Tweed onderzoekt het mechanisme van betekenisgeving en het vertellen van verhalen. McNamee-Tweed omarmt een breed materiaalonderzoek en creëert beelden en objecten die nuances van de menselijke ervaring en de materiële werkelijkheid vertellen, meten of uitdrukken. Hoewel veel van zijn werk natuurlijk gesitueerd kan worden binnen de context van het maken van beelden, schilderen en tekenen, werkt McNamee-Tweed veel met klei. De kunstenaar gebruikt inheemse klei en regionale tradities uit zijn thuisland North Carolina en vertrouwt op zowel aloude als eigenzinnige toepassingen van klei en glazuurmateriaal. Hij maakt intieme, gebruiksvoorwerpen en veel dingen die zich tussen categorieën bevinden, zoals functiebestendige objecten, keramische boeken en wandhangende picturale keramiek, waar hij zich de laatste jaren voornamelijk op richt.

McNamee-Tweeds picturale keramiek of 'keramische schilderijen' maken gebruik van nauwgezette technieken, gecontroleerde processen en gematigde experimenten om een op beelden gebaseerde lichamelijkheid te bereiken met overdreven oppervlakken, texturen en visuele effecten. Deze objecten ter grootte van een boek, die nauw verbonden zijn met de hand en het oog, dragen een sterk verhalend element in zich. Vaak met pathos en speelsheid, omvatten zijn verhalen persoonlijke, alledaagse of grandioze overpeinzingen, terwijl zijn stilistische tendensen en formele gevoeligheden referenties van kunsthistorisch tot alledaags omvatten. Vaak reflecteert zijn beeldtaal op tradities van het maken van beelden en objecten, met een bijzondere nadruk op de alledaagse beeldcultuur, de geschiedenis van de schilderkunst en de immense lijn van praktische toepassingen en artistieke expressie met keramiek.

Kevin McNamee-Tweed (VS, 1984) woont en werkt in Durham, North Carolina. Recente solotentoonstellingen waren onder andere in The Greenville County Museum of Art (Greenville, SC), Tatjana Pieters (Gent, België), The Institute of Contemporary Art in Chattanooga, Steve Turner (Los Angeles), Cob Gallery (Londen, UK), L21 Gallery (Mallorca, Spanje) en Dutton (New York). Hij heeft deelgenomen aan groepotentoonstellingen in Duitsland, Frankrijk, Italië, Spanje, IJsland, Griekenland, het Verenigd Koninkrijk en Australië. Recensies van zijn werk zijn verschenen in onder andere Artforum, Art in America, The New York Times, The Los Angeles Times, The Los Angeles Review of Books, Artnet, Glasstire en Hyperallgeric. Hij ontving talrijke prijzen en residencies, waaronder de Ella Fountain Pratt Award, de Mildred Pelzer Grant, de Willhelm and Jane Bodine Fellowship, de Iowa Arts Fellowship en de Montello Foundation Fellowship. Een monografie over zijn keramisch werk werd gepubliceerd door Steve Turner (Los Angeles) in 2020. Komende projecten omvatten tentoonstellingen in Museum Lucien De Gheus in Poperinge, België en JVDW Gallery in Düsseldorf, evenals nieuwe boeken, waaronder een monografie over McNamee-Tweed's interdisciplinaire praktijk. Hij wordt vertegenwoordigd door Steve Turner Gallery (Los Angeles), Dutton Gallery (New York) en Tatjana Pieters (Gent, België).





Ria Bosman is fascinated by colour and matter. Her colourful, abstract artworks include dozens of sketch and workbooks, works on paper, textile paintings, tile and object paintings, and monumental leather and textile structures. Characteristic are the intense colours and minimal, geometric design, rooted in a sophisticated use of colour, a great sensitivity to materials and a strong technical intuition. The pure, colourful imagery of Ria Bosman stem from the inner (experiential) world of the artist, which she expresses with terms such as peace, silence, harmony, balance, connection and intense experience. Therefore, what drives her research are not purely formal-analytical thought processes, but rather a thoroughgoing aesthetic and a consistent attitude to life - a so-called state of mind. Her work aims to evoke a spiritual experience and emotions. She often chooses intuitively - her selection is related to what engages her, and to the subjects that need further rearrangement and attention.

Ria Bosman (BE, 1956) lives and works in Ghent (BE). Selected solo exhibitions include 'In Between Points, Things Happen', Tatjana Pieters, Ghent (BE), 'GANDA', EbbenGoud, Ghent (BE), Copyright, Ghent (BE), 'ODE', Tatjana Pieters, Ghent (BE), 'VISCERAL COLOUR FIELDS', Tatjana Pieters, Ghent (BE), Galerie C. De Vos, Aalst (BE), Huize Bonaventura, Ghent (BE), Villa des Roses, Ghent (BE), Galerie Avantgarde, Antwerp (BE) and 'Linea '81', Floraliapaleis, Ghent (BE). In 2022, Borgerhoff & Lamberigts published the first comprehensive catalog on Bosman's oeuvre «Selected Works 1978-2021,» with contributions by Isabelle De Baets, Wim Lambrecht & Paul De Moor, designed by Luc De Rycke. RIA BOSMAN

Ria Bosman is gefascineerd door kleur en materie. Haar kleurrijke, abstracte kunstwerken omvatten tientallen schets- en werkboeken, werken op papier, textielschilderijen, tegel- en objectschilderijen en monumentale leer- en textielstructuren. Kenmerkend zijn de intense kleuren en minimale, geometrische vormgeving, geworteld in een geraffineerd kleurgebruik, een grote gevoeligheid voor materialen en een sterke technische intuïtie. De pure, kleurrijke beelden van Ria Bosman komen voort uit de innerlijke (ervarings)wereld van de kunstenaar, die ze uitdrukt met termen als rust, stilte, harmonie, balans, verbinding en intense ervaring. Wat haar onderzoek drijft zijn dan ook geen puur formeel-analytische denkprocessen, maar eerder een doorgedreven esthetiek en een consequente levenshouding - een zogenaamde state of mind.
