

**Obi Emmanuel Agwam** (B.1999 in Lagos Nigeria), is a painter based in New York City. He started acrylic and oil paintings in 2019 due to a class at his community college. Agwam is an artist that creates portraits that depict ideas of black representation and fantasy. He creates characters that are the culmination of different stories and people. None of the characters are specific, but instead carry a familiarity for the viewer. People see friends, family, and acquaintances through these fantasy characters.

The characters he paints are made with a mix of realism and fantasy. The fantasy draws inspiration from cartoons he has seen, and sometimes, anti black imagery in the past. Body parts are exaggerated and painted with nature around them. The purpose of the exaggeration is to bring forward the themes that being depicted.

Through these characters Agwam deals with emotions, death, and life of black people. The characters' expression and design reaffirm these themes in every painting. The backgrounds of these characters are urban, a callback to his childhood and a source of context for these characters. He uses these characters to depict stories in a way that's digestible for the viewer.

Agwami's artwork also serves as an affirmation for joy. Many of the characters have smiles, smiles that take up a majority of the compositions. These smiles serve one purpose, to make the viewer smile, to remind them of the importance of a smile. He firmly believes that art should be an enjoyable experience, that if he can make people feel joy through his works then his art is worth something.
